

The Dunes Golf Club Matarangi

The Golf Committee Charter

Aim:

To provide a supportive, inclusive and informative environment for all members who play golf at the Dunes Golf Course.

Purpose:

The Golf Committee (the Committee) is a group of representatives from all the members of the Dunes Golf Club Matarangi.

Operating Guidelines and Objectives:

The Committee:

1. Comprises eight paid-up members of the Golf Club, the Dunes Manager and the Dunes Course Manager.
2. The eight members comprise no more than 3 x 18 hole men, 3 x 18 hole ladies, 1 x 9 hole man, 1 x 9 hole lady. For practical reasons the members should be made up of permanent residents.
3. Can co-opt additional members as required.
4. Is confirmed at the AGM. Should more nominations be received than the required number of committee members a secret ballot will be held at the AGM to elect the committee members.
5. Elects its Convenor / Chairperson.
6. Meets on a regular basis (at least once every 2 months). Minutes of meetings are recorded.
7. Actively supports the Dunes Golf Course management and any other Dunes Clubs or Committees to enhance the experience of using the overall Dunes facilities.
8. Develops an annual Golf Programme in consultation with Golf Course Management for distribution to all members.
9. Considers issues raised by members relating to golf and make recommendations to the Golf Course Management or refers to the Match Committee as appropriate.
10. Ensures that all represented players are informed in a timely fashion of anything that could affect their enjoyment of the Golf Course (e.g. communication of any unexpected changes related to their specific Programme).
11. Supports and encourages new membership and new players by providing opportunities for competition and learning to play golf.

A Golf Committee representative attends the Dunes Community Club meetings and provides updates to both Committees about planned activities and events.
